

PALLIATIVE CARE EDUCATION FOR HEALTH PROFESSIONALS 2020

Education is designed to add value to practice; providing Registered Nurses, Enrolled Nurses, Health Care Assistants and other health professionals with key principles, practical knowledge and skills to deliver excellent palliative care.

All courses are led by experienced local Specialist Palliative Care Nurse Educators. Courses are free of charge, except for the Masterclasses which are each \$50 per person.

Fundamentals of Palliative Care (FOPC) *(see pages 3 and 4 for timetable)*

Comprehensive multidisciplinary palliative care education that can be effectively used in all health care settings including General Practice, Hospital, Community and Aged Residential Care facilities. Three sets of FOPC training sessions are held yearly. Each set comprises three full days of training sessions, one month apart. Free workbooks emailed to participants.

Session ONE: Essence of Palliative Care, Ethical Issues, Spiritual Care, Communication Skills.

Session TWO: Pain and Symptom Management, Dementia, Chronic Illness.

Session THREE: Last Days of Life, Loss and Grief, Caring for Ourselves.

Syringe Driver Training *(see page 5 for timetable)*

To assist Registered Nurses to obtain the theoretical knowledge and practical skills required to manage syringe drivers in their place of practice, and for Enrolled Nurses to be competent in checking. Free workbooks will be emailed prior to the training.

Syringe Driver Update *(see page 5 for timetable)*

A shorter training session designed as a refresher for those who do not use syringe drivers regularly.

Masterclasses in Communication, Pain and Symptom Management, and Grief and Loss *(see page 6)*

These masterclasses are designed for Registered Nurses to consolidate and build on knowledge gained in the Fundamentals of Palliative Care training. Please note there is a \$50 charge per person per masterclass.
